- c) I hold no previous convictions for offences against this Act, Dog Act 1976 or Animal Welfare Act 2002 in the past 3 years. If yes, please provide details; and
- d) The particulars shown in this application are true to the best of my knowledge.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CAT OWNERS

The purpose of the Cat Act 2011 is to introduce measures to reduce the large number of stray cats and unwanted kittens being euthanized each year, to encourage responsible cat ownership and provide for better management of the unwanted impacts of cats on the community and the environment.

Notice to be given of changes of recorded information

A cat owner is required to update both the Local Government where the cat is registered, and the relevant microchip database company, **within seven days** if there are any changes to the information that either organisation is required to keep.

PLEASE NOTE:

- (1) In addition to the Cat registration number tag each cat must also have a tag which is inscribed the owners name and address. These can be obtained from the R.S.P.C.A., Pet Shops and other sources.
- (2) Maximum number of cats to be kept on any premises is two (2) over the age of three (3) months. Dispensation can be given to keep more than two (2) cats in some cases, but subject to written request to Shire and certain other conditions being met.
- (3) Definition of a **PENSIONER** is for concessional licensing purposes is as follows;
A person issued with a Pensioner Health Benefit Card.
i.e. Carer's Pension, Aged Pension, Invalid Pension, Widowed Pension, Supporting Parents Pension.

If the owner has been convicted of two (2) or more offences in the previous twelve (12) months, the cat registration can be cancelled. The cat can then be seized.
